
The Architecture & Urban Research Institute is South Korea's first government-funded research institute for architecture and urban space. The Institute was established to create new values for architecture and urban space.

Since its establishment, the Institute has conducted over 600 research projects and has prepared many policy alternatives that have led to changes in architecture and urban space in Korea. We have conducted and implemented in-depth and professional architectural urban policy research, including support for enactment and revision of laws and support for national and local government policy projects.

A change maker to increase the value of the architectural and urban space

We create tangible and meaningful changes through research close to life.

Architectural Policy Research

We conduct research and projects to improve the value of public buildings closely related to the daily living environment of the people, research on policies for the construction service industry for good buildings, and research on various architectural policies for realization of smart cities incorporated with advanced building technologies.

• National Public Building Center

In order for the people to enjoy a high-quality architectural culture in their daily life, the center takes care of legal tasks such as preliminary review of public construction business plans, support and advise on public construction planning and establishment of integrated plans, and support design process management.


• Architectural Services Industry Promotion Center

The center conducts policy and institutional research, survey analysis and production of statistics, and research on standardization of building services to foster the building service industry as a knowledge-based service industry at the level of developed countries.

Smart City Research Center

The center conduct research for smart architecture and urban development, such as improving spatial policies and systems for smart architecture cities, providing consulting support for local governments, and operating a comprehensive policy portal to realize a smart city that can be experienced by the people.





Sustainable Urban Research

We seek solutions in the field of spatial policy to address changes in national and social conditions such as climate change, carbon neutrality, low birth rates, and aging populations. We are actively diagnosing new urban space problems and conducting extensive research to enhance urban sustainability and quality.

• Pedestrian Environment Research Center

We are making efforts to study the theory of pedestrian environment and behavior, to study the improvement of laws to promote pedestrian rights, and to develop principles and evaluation standards for pedestrian environments.

• CPTED Research Center

The center carries out development of crime prevention environment design policy and Korean crime prevention environment design, and support for crime prevention environment creation projects of the national and local governments.

• National Green Building Center

We conduct research on policy development in architecture and urban fields in accordance with the major agendas of the new climate system and promote policy support projects according to the Green Building Construction Support Act.





Architectural & Urban Culture Research

We are conducting various theoretical and practical studies on places for the purpose of promoting the spatial culture of Korean architecture and cities. In addition, we promote related policy proposals and education and publicity projects to widely publicize architecture and urban culture of Korea.

National Hanok Center

We support systems and projects for revitalizing hanok architecture, establish a knowledge base for systematizing hanok information, and conduct related research and projects with the goal of expanding networks for the globalization of hanok culture.

Architectural Culture and Asset Center

We study ways to promote national architectural culture, form regional identity, and enhance the value of architectural cultural assets. We carry out research and projects such as building a database of architectural cultural assets, operating an information system, supporting architectural cultural asset policies, and providing education and publicity.

National Landscape Center

In order to form a beautiful and pleasant national landscape, we implement various policies, related research, project implementation, legal system improvement, consulting, etc. to establish and operate a national landscape management system.

• Community Regeneration Center

We derive on-site action plans for regional regeneration, conduct on-site surveys and research for the development of urban regeneration-related systems, establish public-private cooperation (PPP) urban regeneration procedures and systems, and conduct research and projects such as job creation through small and medium-sized urban regional management companies.

• Rural Spatial Research Center

We conduct research and policy support projects to enhance the effectiveness of rural space policies that can respond to uncontrolled rural development and population decline, foster locally driven innovation and improvements to the settlement environment, and improve the field applicability of rural specialized districts.

Building Codes & Legislation Research

In order to improve the safety, function, environment, and aesthetics of buildings, which are the base of people's lives, and to improve the quality of the spatial environment surrounding buildings, we seek systematic maintenance and effective legislative alternatives. In order to improve and implement preemptive building legislation that flexibly responds to changing social conditions and spatial demand, we promote convergent and practical research and projects.

Better Regulation for Buildings & Space Research Center

We conduct post-impact assessment and monitoring of building regulations with the aim of establishing a virtuous cycle of building regulation innovation, and conduct research and policy support projects for systematic maintenance of building regulations.

Bigdata Research

We establishes an information-based objective and rational response system according to changes in social and policy conditions such as the 4th Industrial Revolution. In order to establish a DNA (Data, Network, Al) ecosystem of architectural and urban spatial information closely related to people's lives, the center conducts research on standardization of the entire life cycle of architectural and urban spatial big data such as production, construction, and utilization of related information.

National Facility Management Research Center

Established in accordance with the Building Management Act, the center conducts research, development, and distribution of national policies and technologies to ensure the safety of buildings and maintain and improve the value of use such as convenience, comfort, beauty, and functions during the building life cycle.

Housing Culture Research

We are conducting policy research to improve the quality of housing and residential environments, which are the spaces most closely related to our lives. Rather than evaluating a house only by its real estate value, we diagnose the quantity and quality of residential space suitable for all of us to live and prepare practical alternatives to form and spread a future-oriented housing culture.

Age-Friendly Communities Research Center

With the goal of creating an age-friendly urban building environment, we are improving laws and preparing guidelines, conducting a survey on the perception and satisfaction level of the elderly in the urban building environment, and establishing and diagnosing age-friendly diagnostic standards.

Forum & Seminar

We hold forums and international seminars on policy and social issues in the architecture and urban fields. In addition, through the Architecture and Urban Policy Research Network Seminar, current policy issues are discussed and exchanged with the Regional Development Institute.

The AURI Architecture and Urban Forum, Debate on Architectural Culture

The institute holds the AURI Architecture and Urban Research Forum on policies and social issues in the architecture and urban engineering sectors and various events where media and cultural experts participate as panels to share meaningful discussions.

International Seminars

AURI hosts international seminars where foreign government agencies and research institutions are invited to share policies and best practices of each country.
